Firstly, somehow it doesn't feel right not to mention and think of all those people so seriously affected by the recent Cyclone Gabrielle. There will be many many of us outside of those regions devastated, that have or know of relatives, friends and acquaintances impacted, and our very genuine thoughts are with all. Please keep safe.

Our Club has just completed its first six months of trading of this financial year (to 31st January 2023) and it is very clear that our level of income is seriously lower than the even conservative amount that we had budgeted for, while many of our costs have risen dramatically - for example - our annual insurance premium jumped 45%, or by \$17,562.00, from \$38,735 to \$56,297, (all figures exclude GST too!!). Your Committee is currently under-taking a complete review of our operations and possible outcome(s) for the full year, and it is evident from the assessments undertaken so far, that we must encourage more regular patronage by members of our Club, which will surely help to minimize the prospect of large price increases which should be our last resort option.

We know, based on previous years of experience, member attendances should now be picking up, especially as Adjunct activities increase after the summer break, but it is fair to reveal to all to say the financial team remains nervous of what our new actual business norm will turn out to be.

So please come on down with your friends and buddies as often as is practical for you, to enjoy our facilities and prices that are so frequently favourably commented upon by visitors.



On behalf of our Members, Executive and Staff Members, the Club has donated **\$1,000** to the Cyclone Relief fund via Clubs New Zealand.

Our thoughts are with all the people and families affected by the Cyclone.

(Additional \$40 for hire of rods if applicable)


