
This poses a threat to our members, and to our staff when they are leaving after their shifts.

Honesty is the best policy

I know the CNZ 8Ball rules don't actually stipulate that you give yourself up after a cue foul or inadvertently touching a ball with your finger, arm or part of your clothing, but this is a sport after all and is deserving of good sportsmanship. The game has come a long way from the days of dimly lit billiard parlours full of shady unsavoury characters.

So when you make a foul shot or cue foul, own up to it, instead of continuing to play hoping your opponent doesn't notice. It's in your best interest as a sportsman to own your mistake because even if your opponent doesn't notice, someone else may and you could be labelled a cheat in that person's mind. In the interests of good sportsmanship, I would also advocate to informing your opponent of a free ball or Combo situation rather than hoping they don't notice or don't know the rules. I'd love to see our sport renowned for the integrity and sportsmanship shown by all those that play this fine game.
